WHAT IS JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT?



WHAT IS YOUR ROLE?

Partner with a Life Skills teacher to share JA's practical, fun, and engaging curriculum in an 8th grade classroom for six weekly visits of 45 minutes each. Share your enthusiasm and life experience with kids in your community. While you may choose to volunteer in your child's classroom, you do not have to have an 8th grader at Jones to participate.
